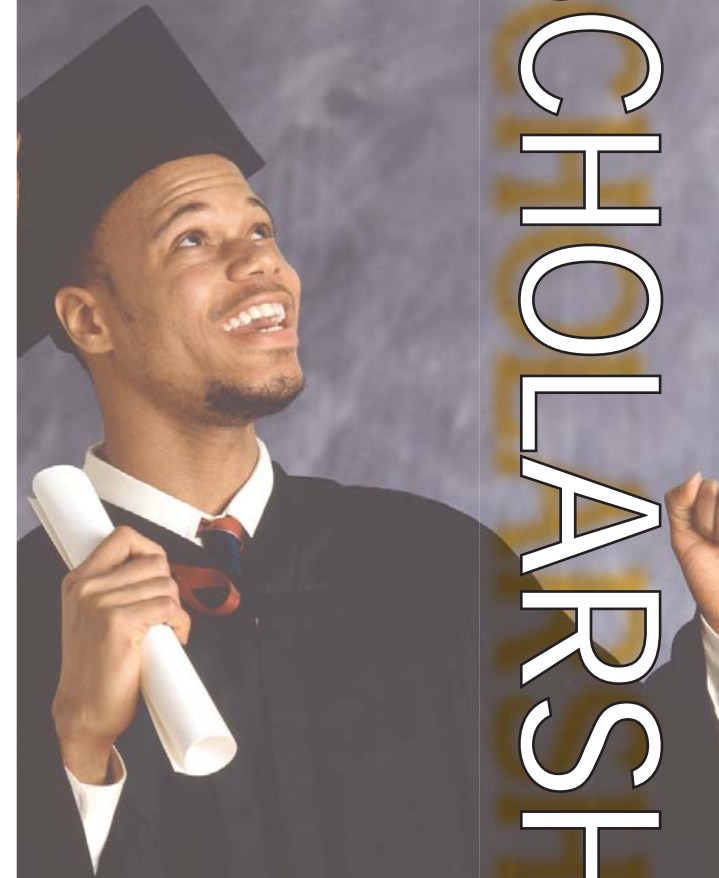
The UFCW Canada National Council also created the scholarship to help working families cope with the ever-increasing cost of post-secondary education, which is so important in today's world.

Qualifications and Eligibility

The Beggs – Dowling – Mathieu Scholarship is worth \$1,000 and the National Council proudly awards it to 18 UFCW Canada members every year. You, and your spouse and children, are eligible to apply for the scholarship if you are a UFCW Canada member in good standing and are attending full-time studies at a Canadian university, college, or other recognized post-secondary institution.

You can apply for the Beggs – Dowling – Mathieu Scholarship every year of your program, but you can only receive the award once.

To make sure UFCW Canada members in every part of the country have a chance to win the scholarship, the National Council distributes the award on a regional basis:

Atlantic Provinces: two scholarships

Quebec: five scholarships

Ontario: six scholarships

Western Provinces: five scholarships

Applying for the Beggs – Dowling – Mathieu Scholarship is easy. You can apply online or by completing this application form and sending it to the UFCW Canada national office. The deadline for receiving applications is September 30.

The National Council may publish the names and photos of successful applicants in DIRECTIONS (the national newsletter) and all winners will be required to provide proof of their enrolment.
