COVID-19 - PROTECTING YOURSELF IS YOUR RIGHT

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO IF YOU BELIEVE YOU WERE EXPOSED TO THE VIRUS AT WORK:

- 1. If you have no symptoms or diagnosis BUT have confirmed cases in your workplace complete a WSIB exposure form.
- 2. If you have symptoms and are unsure get tested.
- 3. If you have symptoms and a diagnosis fill out and submit a Form 6.

This illness and the long-term effects are unknown. A paper trail of contact and exposure is extremely important to ensure you have coverage if you develop symptoms down the road.

If you cannot trace your exposure to the community, your family or friends and there are positive cases of COVID-19 in your workplace – big or small – then you need to submit a Form 6 or Exposure Report.

If you contract COVID-19 at work, it is an occupational disease.
