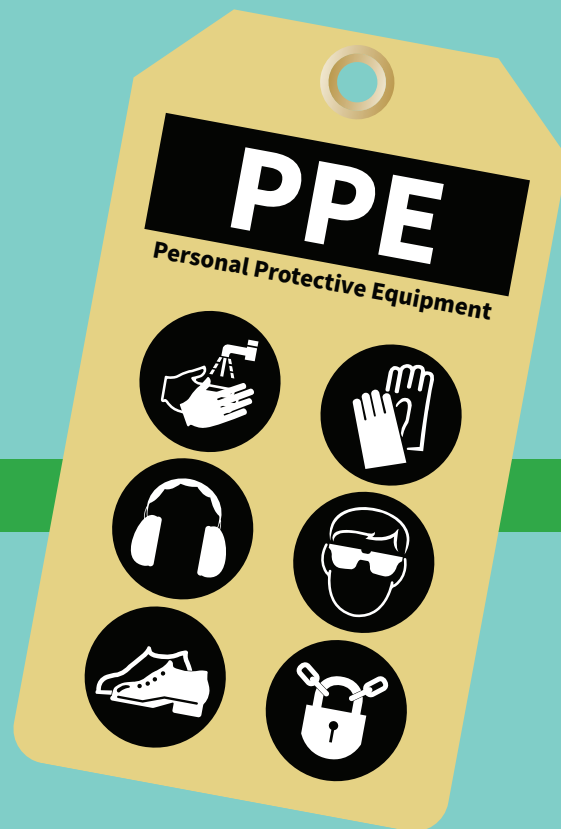

What is Personal Protective Equipment?

Personal protective equipment (PPE) is equipment or clothing worn to minimize exposure to hazards in the workplace.

It can be safety glasses, welding shield, dust mask, cut resistant gloves, respirator, hard hat, ear plugs, ear muffs, safety shoes or safety boots and more.

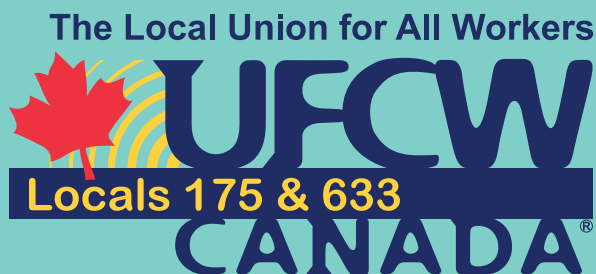
If you must work with an identified hazard that cannot be eliminated, PPE may be required to protect you at work!
